


Introduction

Awareways, located at Euclideslaan 141, 3584 BR Utrecht, is responsible for the processing of personal data as set out in this privacy statement. Our privacy statement is based on the current legal obligation (General Data Protection Regulation & the ePrivacy Directive). The collection of personal data takes place in accordance with these guidelines.

In addition, this privacy statement is based on our own vision on privacy and security. Every choice we make is a balance in which we critically assess the privacy and functionality for our visitors. Therefore, we consciously choose European providers, hosting in the Netherlands, and minimal logging. Moreover, this statement is written in clear and understandable language, without unnecessary legal jargon, so that you truly understand what happens to your data. Finally, we ensure that data is automatically deleted as soon as it is no longer necessary for the purpose for which it was collected.

Collection of personal data

We collect your data from the moment you enter or leave your data on our website, or register or are registered in any other way to use our services. We may also collect data from you if you have posted it on public resources (such as job boards like LinkedIn, Monster, etc.) which might indicate that you would be interested in work-related services. In that case, we may approach you to see if you are interested in registering with us in accordance with our terms and conditions and in observance of this Privacy statement.

Personal data we process

Awareways processes your personal data because you use our services and/or because you provide this data to us yourself.

Below is an overview of the personal data we process:

- IP address;
- Data about your activities on our website;
- Internet browser and device type.

When you contact us, we also collect the following data:

- First and last name;
- Email address;
- Telephone number (if provided).

Special and/or sensitive personal data we process

No special and sensitive personal data is collected via our website and/or service. Awareways also does not intend to collect data about website visitors who are younger than 16, unless they have permission from parents or a guardian. However, we cannot verify whether a visitor is older than 16. We therefore recommend that parents are involved in their children's online activities to prevent data about children from being collected without parental consent. How long we store personal data

Awareways does not store your personal data for longer than is strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which your data is collected. The retention period for all collected data is 14 months.

Cookies

Awareways uses functional, analytical and tracking cookies. A cookie is a small text file that is stored in the browser of your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit this website. Awareways uses cookies with a purely technical functionality. These ensure that the website works properly and that, for example, your preferred settings are remembered. These cookies are also used to make the website work well and to be able to optimise it. In addition, we place cookies that track your browsing behaviour so that we can offer customised content and advertisements.

During your first visit to our website, we already informed you about these cookies and asked for your permission to place them. Functional cookies are required to make the website work. You can choose whether you accept the marketing, tracking (preferences) and statistics cookies (opt-in). You can refuse this with one click.

You can opt out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it no longer stores cookies. In addition, you can also delete all information previously stored via your browser's settings. Click here for more information about Cookies.

Accessing, modifying or deleting data

You have the right to access, correct or delete your personal data. In addition, you have the right to withdraw any consent you have given for data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by Awareways, and you have the right to data portability. This means that you can submit a request to us to send the personal data we hold about you in a computer file to you or another organisation named by you.

You can send a request for access, correction, deletion, data transfer of your personal data or a request for withdrawal of your consent or objection to the processing of your personal data to support@awareways.com.

To ensure that the request for access has been made by you, we ask you to send a copy of your identity document with the request. In this copy, black out your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and Citizen Service Number (BSN). This is to protect your privacy. We will respond to your request as soon as possible, but no later than within four weeks.

How we secure personal data

Awareways takes the protection of your data seriously and takes appropriate measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorised access, unwanted disclosure and unauthorised modification.
